BUSES

Plymouth City Bus is the main form of transport around the city and surrounding areas. The routes are extensive, but they do not run for 24 hours, so please check the route before you begin an adventure.

TAXI

There is a broad selection of taxi firms throughout the city, with the most being found in the taxi loading area next to Drake Circus south entrance. We would recommend requesting a quote, prior to getting in the taxi.

FERRY

There are a number of ferries in Plymouth, which enable easy access to areas via the water. All of these areas, have bus routes at the port of landing to explore further. 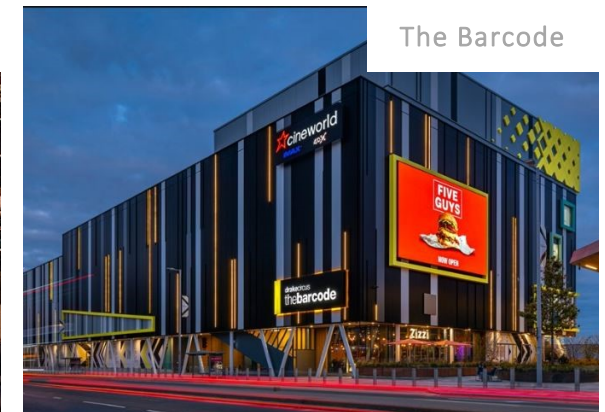

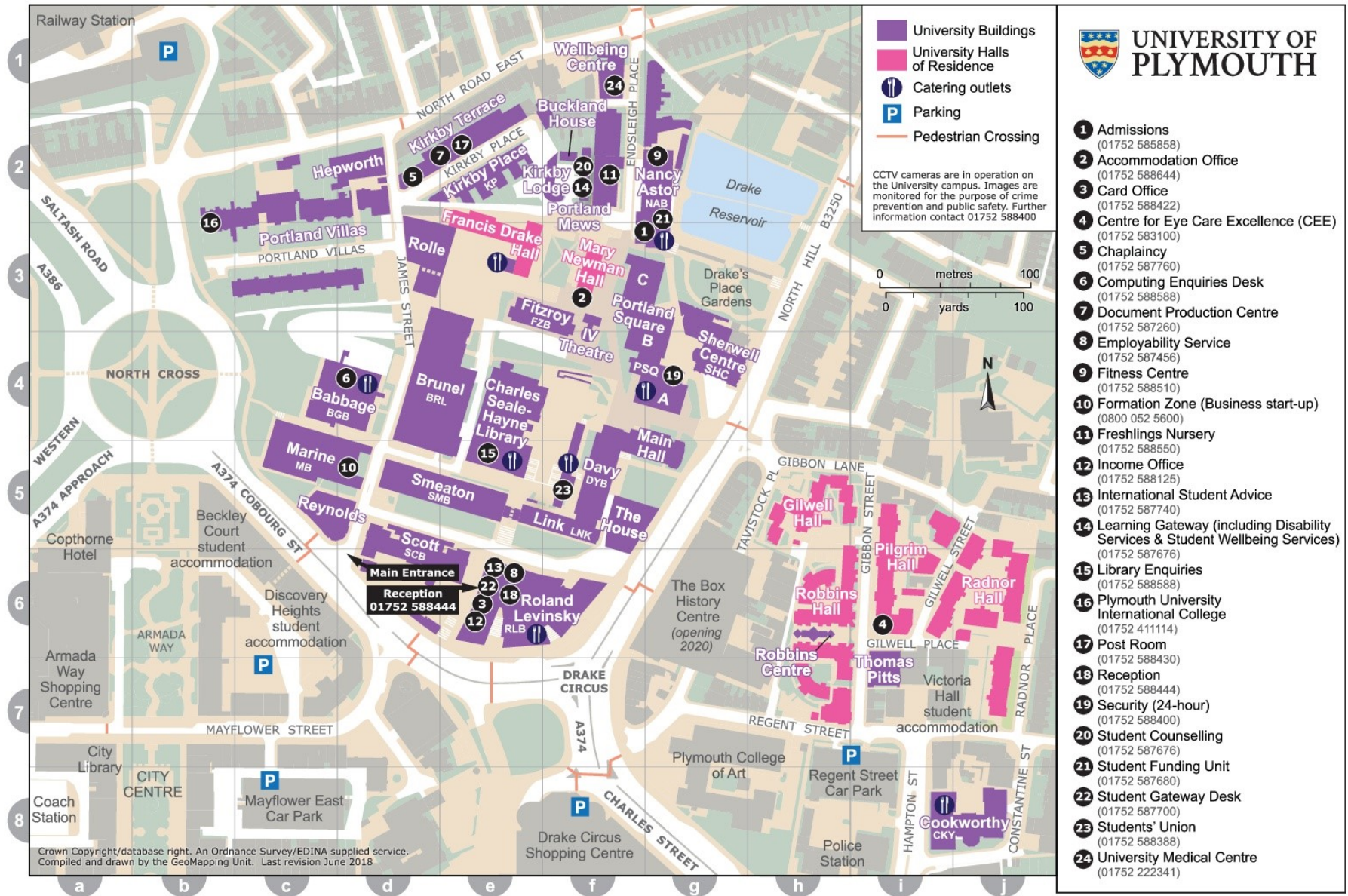

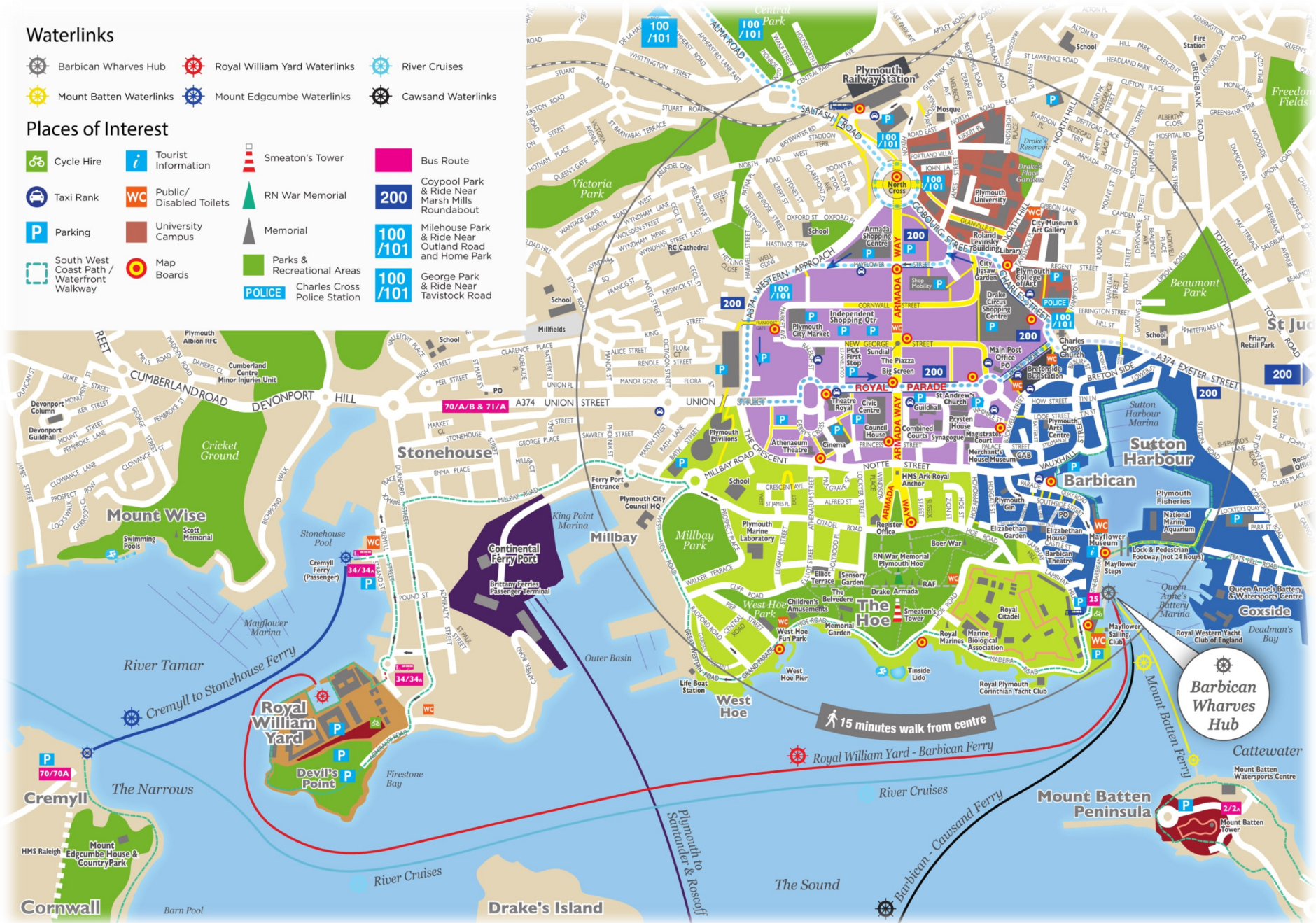
